ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 1990-1

PRESENT: HON. ROBERT J. CHRZANOWSKI, CHIEF JUDGE

Pursuant to MCR 6.104(G), the following procedure is adopted by the 16th Judicial Circuit to permit daily arraignments of defendants and establishment of bond each day of the year.

1. The Chief Judge of each district shall insure that a judicial officer shall be available on each week day to preside over arraignments of defendants arrested for the commission of a felony.

2. The District Judges of the county shall, on a rotating basis, and after having received countywide jurisdiction from the State Court Administrative Office, conduct arraignments of defendants arrested for the commission of felonies on Saturday, Sunday and any holiday occurring on a Monday.

This order is in ratification of the procedure which has been in effect since April 1, 1990 and shall continue until further order of this Court.
