The Macomb County Circuit Court and the Eastpointe Municipal Court enter into this agreement under the authority of MCL 712A.2e.

The Macomb County Circuit Court Family Division agrees to waive jurisdiction to the Eastpointe Municipal Court over all traffic and municipal civil infraction actions which are brought within the jurisdiction of the Eastpointe Municipal Court against persons under the age of 17. The Eastpointe Municipal Court agrees to accept jurisdiction. However, if a civil infraction within the scope of this order arises from the same transaction or occurrence as a misdemeanor proceeding within the jurisdiction of the Macomb County Circuit Court Family Division, both matters are to be handled by the Macomb County Circuit Court Family Division.
