
Local Administrative Order No. 2002-4

Barriers to implementation of the Family Division, the transfer of Chief Probate Judge Pamela Gilbert O'Sullivan to the Probate Court and the recent assignment of Juvenile Division cases to individual judges in the Family Division has led to the need for a mechanism for judges of the Family Division to assist with the docket of the other judges of the Family Division, for the efficient handling of the business of the Court;

Therefore, the judges of the Family Division shall serve as "alternate judge" for the other judges of the Family Division as needed. The Family Division alternate judge shall be authorized to perform acts for the other judges of the Family Division, including but not limited to, reviewing and signing orders in the Juvenile Division of the Court and handling miscellaneous matters.

This Order is complementary to and not inconsistent with LAO 2002-3, providing for an alternate judge within the Circuit Court building to handle miscellaneous matters in the absence of other judges.

This order is effective on June 20, 2002.
