
It is the responsibility of the referee to notify the State Court Administrative Office of changes in the individual's contact information during the course of the appointment.

2. John D. Brennan:
 - a. Will serve at the pleasure of the Chief Judge of the Macomb Circuit Court.
 - b. Has taken the constitutional oath of office.
 - c. Is licensed to practice law in Michigan.
3. Referee John D. Brennan is authorized to perform the following duties pursuant to MCR 3.913 and MCL 712A.10:
 - a. Conduct a preliminary inquiry to preside at hearings under the Juvenile Code, MCL 712A.1, et seq., and make recommended findings and conclusions except for those hearings specified in MCR 3.912(A), which include the following:
 1. a jury trial;
 2. a waiver proceeding under MCR 3.950;
 3. the preliminary examination, trial and sentencing in a designated case;
 4. a proceeding on the issuance, modification or termination of a

- b. In conducting hearings, a referee shall do all of the following:
1. administer oaths and examine witnesses;
 2. if a case requires a hearing and the taking of testimony, make a written signed report to the judge containing a summary of the testimony taken and a recommendation for the court's findings and disposition.

This Order shall take effect immediately upon approval by the State Court Administrative Office.
